Monthly Tuition / Due Dates

Tuition is charged to your required bank account on file the 1st of the month. Account will be billed and an email statement will be sent as a reminder on the 1st of the month. Once tuition post you will be able to log into your parent portal and click "pay now" **or** your balance will be pulled automatically on the 1st of the month by the banking information on file. Whichever is easiest for you! **Please note, you are welcome to pay by cash / check / Venmo as well however, it will have to be submitted BEFORE the 1st or banking information will be used on file.** Please be sure your banking information on file is accurate and updated at all times. A \$35 fee for any ACH charges returned from the bank will be added to your account. If tuition fee is not paid by the 5th of the month, a late fee of \$5.00 will be applied. All payments must be current for dancers to receive costumes, participate in class, or perform in any show or recital.

Dress code

It is very important for your child to come ready to dance in the appropriate dancewear. Athletic clothing is required. However, we do prefer proper dance wear. Tights, leggings, leotards, shorts, tank tops and sports bras. Check out our apparel that is available for purchase at the studio or take advantage of our apparel link that will be sent out the second week of class. Absolutely no jeans, gum, or jewelry allowed. Hair must be pulled back out of dancer's face.

Attendance Standards

Students must be ready to enter class on time, have used the restroom, with hair up in the appropriate dress code as listed above. Contact Next Level Dance or Lexy Stroud-Abbott if your child is going to miss class for any reason. If your child is sick, please do not send to dance class. This will prevent sickness from spreading as our dancer's safety is our top priority. Monthly fee will *NOT* be discounted due to missed classes. Your dancer is able to make up classes if missed in a class that is appropriate for their specific age.

Dance Shoes

Dancers will be sized either at our open house, shoe sizing dates, or the first class attended. Shoes are mandatory as we want to ensure dancers are receiving the best possible instruction. If your dancer does not show up the first week of class with the proper shoe, dancers will be sized and shoe order will be placed / cost will be applied to your account.

Classroom Atmosphere

The classroom atmosphere revolves around supporting each other while setting goals for one another. Focusing on reaching our highest potential is important for our students' mindset. The culture of our team centers around commitment, believing, and grasping the master of learning. We want to enforce these skills both inside and outside of the classroom.

Belongings

When dancers enter the studio please place your items in a cubie of your choice. Next Level Dance is not responsible for any lost items. If teachers / staff notice something was left behind they will place in our lost and found bin that is located when entering the studio. ABSOULTY NO FOOD ALLOWED. We encourage dancers to bring a water bottle. Water bottles must be placed in your cubie.

Class Cancellations

Next Level Dance may cancel class due to inclement weather. We will send out an email and update our studio's Facebook page. Check both for the fastest and most accurate information. The cancelled classes will not be rescheduled or refunded, but students are allowed to make up these classes within the next month by attending a class that fits into their age group.

Parent Observation

Parents will not be able to enter the studio at any time during class hours. (except our "Dance With Me" course) We understand that adjusting to the first few classes may be difficult for some of our younger students. We permit parents to join students for the first few classes until dancers warm up to their teachers, peers and surroundings. Parents will be invited in during our Parent observation weeks the last 10 minute of dancer's class to view class skills & celebrate dancers' success / growth. View calendar for observation weeks.

Recital Information

A performance will take place at the end of the dance season (June 5th, 2022) at Western Dubuque High School for students to showcase their routines they have been practicing. We welcome friends, family, and the community to attend. Each family will receive a packet with detailed information on May 2nd-5th. We ask that you read this packet completely and as thoroughly as possible.

Recital Fee

A recital fee of \$25.00 will be collected in one transaction on April 1st when regular tuition fees are due per family. This fee covers the space of the theater where our rehearsal / performance will take place.

Costume Fee

Costume fees will be collected in two different transactions when regular tuition fees are due. ½ December 1st & ½ January 1st.

Costume cost: \$55.00 per costume / class
